# Joe Dallas





Joe Dallas is an author, conference speaker, and pastoral counselor. He's the founder of Cloudfire Ministries in Tustin, California, which is a counseling ministry for men dealing with sexual addiction and other sexual/relational problems. He also serves on the Elder Board of Mesa Church, and received his Master's Degree in Christian Counseling from Vision University. Joe is a member of the American Association of Christian Counselors, hosts a weekly video podcast called Christians in a Cancel Culture, and a weekly Facebook Live teaching series called Sound Doctrine Bites.

Joe has authored nine books, and is a contributing writer for The Christian Research Journal and the online magazine The Stream. His articles have appeared in Christianity Today (cover story June 1993), The Journal of Christian Healing, and The Southern California Christian Times. His work has also been featured in The Los Angeles Times, Moody Monthly, New Man Magazine and The Boston Globe.

For over three years, Joe taught and conducted the nationally recognized Every Man's Battle 5-Day conference as the originating Program Director. From 1991 to 1993, he served as the President of Exodus International. He was also a regularly featured speaker for 13 years with the Focus on the Family Love Won Out conference.

Joe has represented the Christian viewpoint through a number of media appearances, including Focus on the Family Daily Broadcast, Family News in Focus, ABC Evening News, The Bible Answer Man, New Life Live, The 700 Club, Jay Sekalow Live, and Concerned Women of America. He has addressed conferences, churches, and universities across the country, including the Promise-Keepers Men's Conference, Moody Bible Church of Chicago, The Christian Association for Professional Studies, Princeton Theological Seminary, and the Experience Conference. He has also lectured and debated in Norway, Denmark, Switzerland, Mexico, Hong Kong, Canada, Geneva, and Spain.

Joe is the father of two sons. He and his wife Renee reside in Orange County, California.

#### First Aid/CPR - (8:30 AM Start-time) - Friday Only, all day - \$50.00

A certified course in standard First aid, adult CPR, and AED will be offered as one course. Certification will be valid for 2 years. Cost of the course must be paid in full at time of registration. Space is limited.

#### Training Academy – (8:30 AM Start-time) THIS CLASS IS BY INVITATION ONLY \$ 30.00

This seminar prepares leaders to teach other leaders in the Rangers Ministry Academy and is a prerequisite for attending all other academies. Training academy will take place during all Friday and Saturday Education Sessions.

She co-wrote a book, Doing Life Together: Building Community, she travels and speaks around the country encouraging churches, corporations, and small businesses to begin to engage in the life of individuals affected by disability. Sib and her husband Jess Charles – who became a quadriplegic in his late teens following a farming accident – advocated together for the needs of individuals affected by disability during their 30 years of marriage. Sib's passion is to see individuals and families affected by disability not only survive but thrive on their life journey!
